The County was gracious enough to donate 3 surplus vehicles to the City of Keystone Heights approximately 12 years ago for use at our airport. Two of these vehicles served as primary transportation within airport property, but they ran their course. We currently utilize the third vehicle as a "Crew Car" for transient pilots who fly into our airfield and need transportation to local restaurants and/or accommodations due to inclement weather. This vehicle is a 2002 Chevy Impala and has 160K miles. Those miles are starting to show on the 'ol girl and it's becoming more to maintain each month. Having a crew car at our facility not only helps pilots decide where they will fly for fuel and services, but also helps stimulate our local economy by getting them to local shopping and restaurants.

Please accept this as a formal request from the City of Keystone Heights for the Keystone Heights Airport Authority for any possible surplus vehicles the County may have currently or in the future.
