## ORDINANCE NO. 2021-\_\_\_\_

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CLAY COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CLAY COUNTY 2040 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN INITIALLY ADOPTED PURSUANT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 163.3184, FLORIDA STATUTES, UNDER ORDINANCE NO. 2018-31, AS SUBSEQUENTLY AMENDED, IN ORDER TO AMEND EXHIBIT G TRANSPORTATION ELEMENT TO UPDATE APPENDIX FIGURE 1, THE 2040 TRAFFIC CIRCULATION MAP, TO BE CONSISTENT WITH THE MOBILITY FEE PROJECTS INCLUDED IN THE CLAY COUNTY MOBILITY FEE ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on June 26, 2018, the Board of County Commissioners of Clay County, Florida (the "Board"), adopted Ordinance No. 2018-31, which adopted the Clay County 2040 Comprehensive Plan (the "Plan"); and,

WHEREAS, Section 163.3184, Florida Statutes, outlines the process for the adoption of comprehensive plans or amendments thereto; and,

WHEREAS, the Board desires to amend the Plan as provided for below.

Be It Ordained by the Board of County Commissioners of Clay County that:

Section 1. Clay County Ordinance No. 2018-31, as amended, is amended as provided in Section 2 hereof.

Section 2. Figure 1 of Exhibit G of the Plan (Transportation Element) is hereby amended as provided for in Attachment A-1.

<u>Section 3.</u> If any provision or portion of this Ordinance is declared by any court of competent jurisdiction to be void, unconstitutional or unenforceable, then all remaining provisions and portions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section 4.</u> The Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners is authorized and directed within 10 days of the date of adoption of this Ordinance to send a certified, complete and accurate copy of this Ordinance by U. S. Mail to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity, the Caldwell Building, 107 East Madison Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-4120, the Northeast Florida Regional Council, 100 Festival Park Avenue, Jacksonville, Florida 32202, and any other

agency or local government that provided timely comments as specified in Section 163.3184, Florida Statutes.

<u>Section 5.</u> In accordance with Section 163.3184, Florida Statutes, if the Plan amendment provided by this Ordinance is not timely challenged, then the effective date of said Plan shall be the  $31^{st}$  day after the date the Department of Economic Opportunity notifies the County that the Plan amendment is complete. If the Plan amendment is timely challenged, however, said effective date shall be the date a final order is entered by the Department of Economic Opportunity or the Administrative Commission determining the amendment to be in compliance. No development orders, development permits or land uses dependent on this Plan amendment may be issued or commence before they have become effective.
